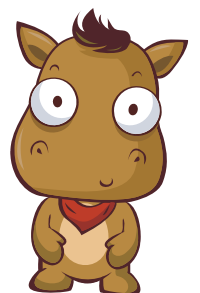
Bug Club

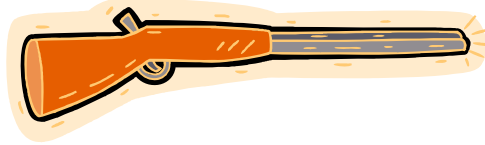

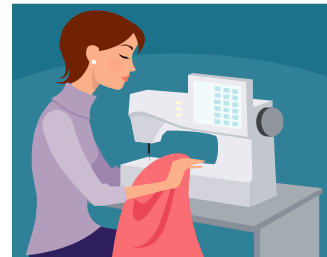

The Lieutenant Governor's office is taking applications for the 2010 Page Program. Students who are interested should fill out an application with all supporting information to the Lt. Governor's office **November 30, 2009**. There are only 50 slots available for this year's program. Students selected to serve as a Page in the Mississippi Senate and will be notified by **December 31, 2009**. In order for students to be considered, all information must be submitted. Students who are selected will serve one week in the Mississippi Senate/Lt. Governor's Office starting on **January 5, 2010-April 03, 2010**. The week for the students to serve in the Mississippi Senate will be assigned by the Lt. Governor's office, based on space availability. For additional information about the Lt.
