2009 4-H Shooting Sports South Volunteer Training

The Wayne County Vocational Center in Waynesboro, MS will be the meeting site for the next 4-H Shooting Sports Volunteer Leader Training Workshop. It will be held on August 29th-30th. Discipline training will take place inside the Vocational Center with all outdoor activities being held at a local gun range. (There will also be a training held at the Alcorn County High School on October 24th-25th.)

Participants must be at least 21 years of age in order to become a certified volunteer.

To make better use of your resources, individual disciplines will only be offered if at least 5 participants are registered by the final deadline. Any discipline with insufficient registration will not be offered in the final program. Each county may bring one or more agents or volunteers in each of the six disciplines that will be offered; however, at this training session each person can complete certification in only one of the following disciplines: Pistol, Rifle, Muzzleloader, Archery, and Shotgun

TRAINING SCHEDULE

This training requires your attendance and participation for the **DURATION** in order to receive certification for the discipline chosen. In order to cover all of the components during the limited Saturday/Sunday time period, we request that you pay close attention to the agenda that will be handed out during registration on Saturday morning.

REGISTRATION

The prepaid registration cost is \$75.00 per person. This will cover the cost of Saturday breakfast, lunch and dinner, and breakfast Sunday morning with snacks at break times on both days. This fee also covers workshop materials, training equipment, and ammunition. Registration forms should be filled out and returned with a \$75.00

check per person payable to Mississippi 4-H and noted for the 4-H Shooting Sports Volunteer Training. **EARLYBIRD REGISTRATION WILL BE FROM JUNE 22ND -JULY 31ST. REGISTRATIONS RECEIVED AFTER THE 31ST WILL BE CHARGED AN ADDITIONAL \$10.00. ABSOLUTELY NO REGISTRATIONS WILL BE ACCEPTED AFTER NOON ON AUGUST 14TH.
