February and red roses go hand in hand. We will go over some care and handling of this most popular and favorite cut flower. We will also discuss some party planning techniques for the February holidays.

Materials required for the hands-on portion:

- 12 stems of any flower or assortment of flowers, approximately 16 to 20" in length
- Foliages, assortment of 3 sizes
- Short holly branches with red berries or any berried plant to fill in the top
- Container appropriate for a dining table (round or oblong), watertight
- Fresh floral foam soaked and cut to fit your container: one inch left above the top of the container for design purposes
- Fresh branching material

NOTES:

Any type of flower appropriate for a February holiday will work in this arrangement. Check those calendars for options available in your area.

Don't forget your branching material should be pliable so it will bend into a form.
