

Rules for Political Campaign Activities at Truck Crops Experiment Station Mississippi State University

We ask our guests to follow these rules.

Allowed

1. Signs in or on personal vehicles are permissible (even very large ones). Vehicles must be parked in the designated parking area.
2. Walking among guests and audiences -- talking, waving, etc.
3. Wearing items of political persuasion on person.
4. Distributing printed information and premiums (business cards, pamphlets, fans, etc.), as long as such items do not present a safety hazard. Please assist us by keeping the grounds clean of your materials throughout the day.

Not Allowed

1. Attaching signs to university property (fence, ground, vehicles, light poles, etc.)
2. Activities that create an unsafe or disruptive environment
 - a. any activity that slows down traffic entering the Fest is not allowed.
 - b. any activity that causes traffic to stop or slow down on the railroad tracks will not be allowed.
3. Electronic audio or visual presentations, or the use of amplified voice equipment, bullhorns, or loudspeakers outside of those provided by the Fest for the exclusive use by scheduled Fest speakers, presenters, and management
4. Use of university resources such as copiers, phones, office supplies, etc.
5. Parking in undesignated areas
6. Setting up tables or exhibits on our grounds for campaign promotion purposes (our grounds are inside the fence as well as the areas marked off outside the fence.)
