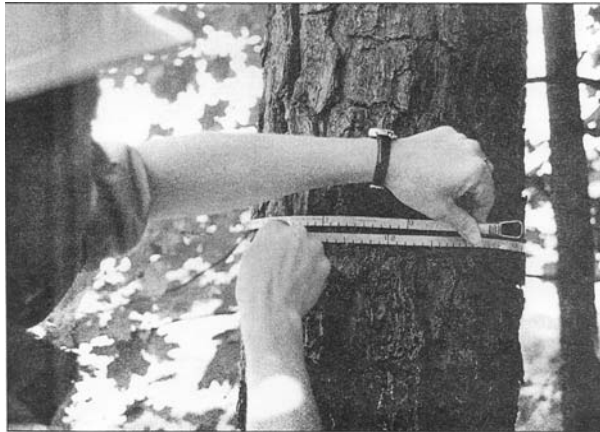
Holmes County Forestry Association

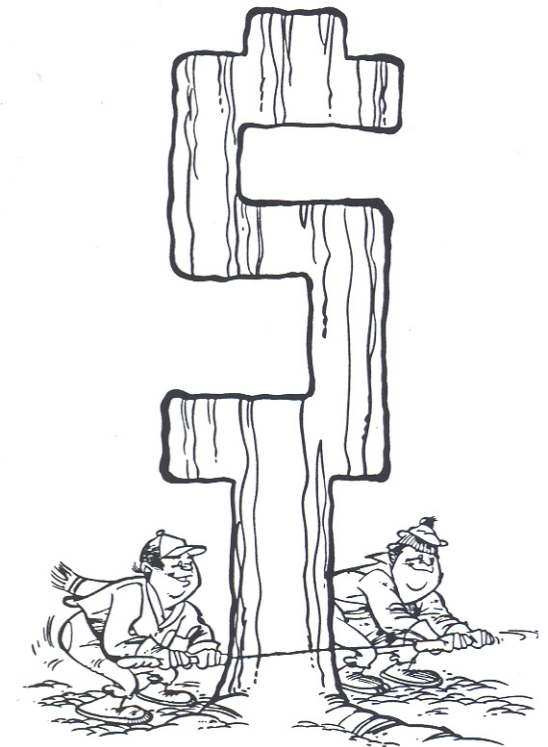

From I-55: When approaching Lexington on Hwy 12 -- pass the Regional Jail on the left - continue 1/2 mile on Hwy 12 to the first blacktop road to the right, Bowling Green Road, (it is marked to direct to Hospital) take this right hand turn and continue 2 miles to the camp house on the right.
