

Hinds CC Bull Test 2011 Spring Bull Sale Results

The Hinds Community College Bull Test Sale was held on March 3, 2011 in conjunction with the Mississippi Beef Cattle Improvement Association spring bull sale. The Hinds Bull Test Sale featured 30 performance-backed bulls from breeders participating in the 2009-2010 Hinds Community College Bull Test. Thank you to all of the consignors and buyers for supporting the Spring 2011 Hinds Bull Test Sale.

The top-selling lot was Harvey MS Pop Top 926, an Angus bull. Harvey MS Pop Top 926 was consigned by Harvey Farms, LLC of Flora, Mississippi and sold for \$3,150 to Jerry Griffin of Newton, Mississippi. Other breeders marketing bulls in the bull test sale included A. Daughdrill Farms, Busted B Farms, E. L. Farms, Monogram Farms, Woods Angus, and Yankee Cutoff Angus Ranch. Sale receipts on thirty bulls totaled \$68,450 for a sale average price of \$2,282.
