Criteria for Judging Program of Work Award Entries



This guide may be helpful in preparing the County Report in each educational area. It will be used in judging the records for State Awards.

Points*	Criteria
15	1. Briefly describe the situation that led your group to initiate the project and state the objective. Include a summary at the end of the report.
15	2. Describe the process of the project(s), including: a. What did MHV do in guiding and carrying out the project(s)? b. What were the involvement and contributions of other agencies or organizations?
30	3. Describe the results of the project(s): a. How well did the project(s) succeed? b. What are future plans for the project(s)? c. What was the number of members or clubs participating? d. What was the number of people reached? e. What was the number of hours volunteered? f. What were the actual dollars expended?
40	4. Describe the overall presentation, appearance, quality of content, and use of visual aids.

NOTE: This can be a single-focus project or a combination of many projects related to the Program of Work area.
