Hay Description

1000 net wrapped large round (4'x5') bales of first cut mixed grass hay (annual ryegrass, bermudagrass, Johnsongrass, crabgrass..). It has not been fertilized or sprayed on this first cut. There are some broadleaf weeds in the hay. This hay is more conducive for beef cattle. Protein ranges from 8-11% and TDN 50-70%. Buyer must pick up at farm. Loading for buyer with advance notice. **WE DO NOT DELIVER** but will load you up and help strap your purchase down.
